

BLOCK OF THE MONTH: JANUARY 2004

APPLIQUE' HEART

6" x 6" finished

- A - cut 1 -  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " off-white
- B - cut 4 -  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " pink (light/medium)
- C - cut 2 -  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow
- D - cut 2 -  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " blue (light/medium)
- Heart - cut 1 - red or dark pink (add seam allowance for turn-under applique' methods)

Method -

Applique' heart to off-white square using a method of your choice (see quilting books and magazines or the internet for different applique' methods)

Sew 2 pink strips to sides of appliqued square. Press seam allowances toward pink strips.

Sew C and D cornerstones to remaining strips. Press toward pink strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of appliqued square. Press seams toward pink strips.

Unfinished square should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "
