

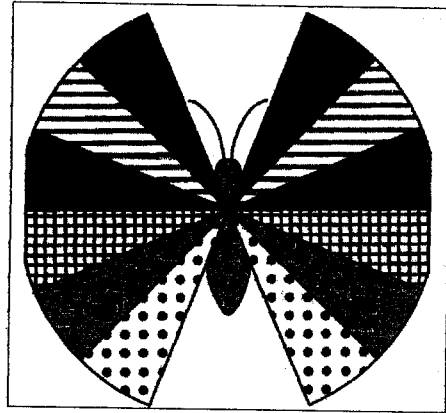
JUNE BLOCK OF THE MONTH

BUTTERFLY

Summer is on the way and what a better way to start your summer quilt than to have a butterfly square to include in your quilt. Or you could just appliqué the completed butterfly onto a larger piece of fabric with other flowers, bugs, etc.

You will need the following fabrics:

- 1) White or white on white (Background)
- 2) 6 shades of one color varying from light to bold.
- 3) body fabric



Cutting:

White fabric = 1 – 10" square

Trace the wing template adding 1/4" seam allowance and cut 2 of each color for the wings

Trace the body template and add 1/4" if you are hand appliquéing.

Assembly:

1. Assemble 2 sets of wings (make sure to reverse one set).
2. Applique the two sets of wings onto the background fabric. (If machine appliquéing trim 1/4" from the completed wing sets).
3. Place the body between the wings and appliqué in place.
4. Embroider the antennae in black.

Trim to 9½" square (includes seam allowances).
