

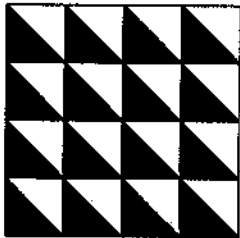
March Block 2004

Mosaic

Unfinished block 8 ½"

Fabric – blue and yellow colors

- 1) Cut 8 3 ¼" squares from each of the yellow and blue fabrics.
- 2) Make 16 2 ½" half square triangles. Place a yellow square on a blue square. Draw a line on the diagonal
- 3) Stitch ¼" each side of the drawn line. Cut on the pencil line.
- 4) Press squares open. Trim squares to make 16 2 ½" square triangles
- 5) Join squares together as shown.
- 6) Press block. Unfinished block is 8 ½" square.

JEWEL BOX 6" x 6" finished block

Cutting Instructions

off white or cream fabric

4 - 2" x 2" squares

1 - 4" x 4" square, cut in half diagonally

spring colors - assorted medium value prints

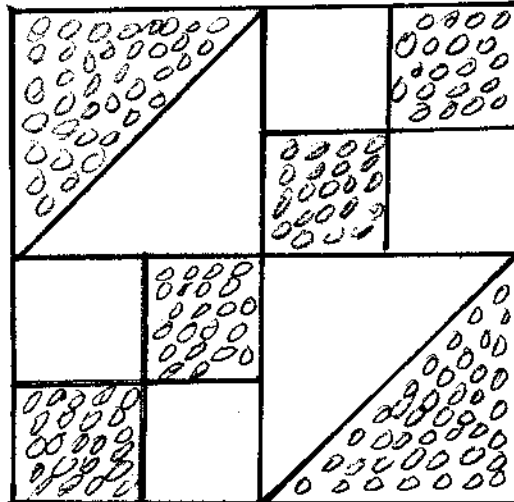
4 - 2" x 2" squares

1 - 4" x 4" square, cut in half diagonally

Sewing Instructions

1. Make 2 4-patch blocks using 2" squares. Press.
2. Make 2 blocks by joining half-square triangles. Press. Trim blocks to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".
3. Join 4-patch and half-square triangle blocks according to diagram. Press.

Block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".



(When joining completed blocks, traditionally you would add light 2" x 6 1/2" sashing strips and 2" x 2" medium square cornerstones. This step may be omitted to create a different effect.)
