

**LANGLEY QUILTER'S GUILD  
BLOCK OF THE MONTH  
FEBRUARY 2005**

**SOUTHWEST SNOWBIRDS** - The geese have flown south for the winter - smart birds!  
(This is a flying geese four-patch.)

Requirements: "Geese" - assorted soft southwest colours (turquoise, yellow, green, peach, blue etc.)

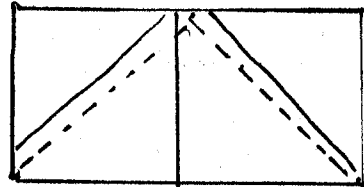
Background - assorted "sandy" colours (light brown, beige)

All fabrics should be solid, tone on tone or subtle prints.

Cutting: 2 each of four colours -  $2\frac{3}{4}$  x 5 inch rectangle

16 background squares -  $2\frac{3}{4}$  x  $2\frac{3}{4}$  inch - assorted sandy colours

Preparation of each goose unit: Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of two background squares, sew one square to each end of a rectangle, trim seam to  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, press. Prepare another identical unit then sew the two units together to form one of the four-patch squares. Make a total of four squares, each with a different colour rectangle.



Assembly: Sew the four patches together following the diagram for the orientation of each block. Block should measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$  inches unfinished.
