

LANGLEY QUILTER'S GUILD
BLOCK OF THE MONTH - JULY 2007 (for August meeting)

LATTICE SQUARE

Colour scheme is country colours (medium to dark green, blue, red or gold) with cream colour lattice strips.

Cutting: (4) 6 inch squares - 1 from each of four different fabrics
(4) lattice strips, each 1 ½ x 9 inches (all from same cream colour fabric)

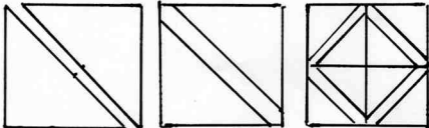
Cut each square on the diagonal (8 half-square triangles)

Assembly: Sort into four pairs, mixing segments so same two are not used in a single block

- Mark centre point of long edge of each triangle (fold in half and finger press or mark with a pencil)
- Mark centre point of both long edges of lattice strips in same manner
- Place a lattice strip right sides together with one of the triangles, matching the centre points. The strip will extend beyond the ends of the triangle and will be trimmed later. Sew with ¼ inch seam.
- Stitch another triangle to the other side of the lattice strip, matching centre points
- Make 4 of these blocks

Press the seams towards the lattice strip. Trim the block to a 6 inch square, keeping the centre line of the strip on the diagonal of the square.

Join the four block so the lattice forms an "O" block
