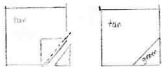


**Langley Quilter's Guild
Block of the Month
September for October 2007**

PUMPKIN BLOCK

Unfinished Block Size: 6 1/2" X 9 1/2"

- From tan background fabric cut: 2 - 3 X 3 1/2 inch rectangles
5 - 1 1/2 x 1/2 inch squares
- From dark green stem fabric cut: 1 - 1 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch rectangle
1 - 1 3/4 x 1 1/4 inch square
- From dark orange print (A) cut: 2 - 1 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch rectangles
1 - 2 1/2 x 4 1/2 inch rectangle
- From medium orange print (B) cut: 4 - 1 1/2 x 4 1/2 inch rectangles



Piecing:

With right sides together, position the 1 3/4" green square on the lower right corner of one 3 x 3 1/2" tan rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the squares and stitch on the line. Check diagram for direction of stitching. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4 inch; press.

Repeat the process for the stem and for the top and bottom corners of the left and right dark orange (A) print pumpkin sides.

Sew the 3 rectangles of the stem section together.

Put the pumpkin section together starting with the middle dark orange (A) rectangle. Stitch the medium orange print (B) 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" rectangles to the left and right of the dark orange (A) center print. Stitch the remaining fabric B rectangles to the top and bottom. Now stitch the 1 1/2 x 6 1/2" dark orange (A) print to the left and right sides - being careful to have the corners matching the diagram placement.

Finally stitch the stem section to the pumpkin section.
