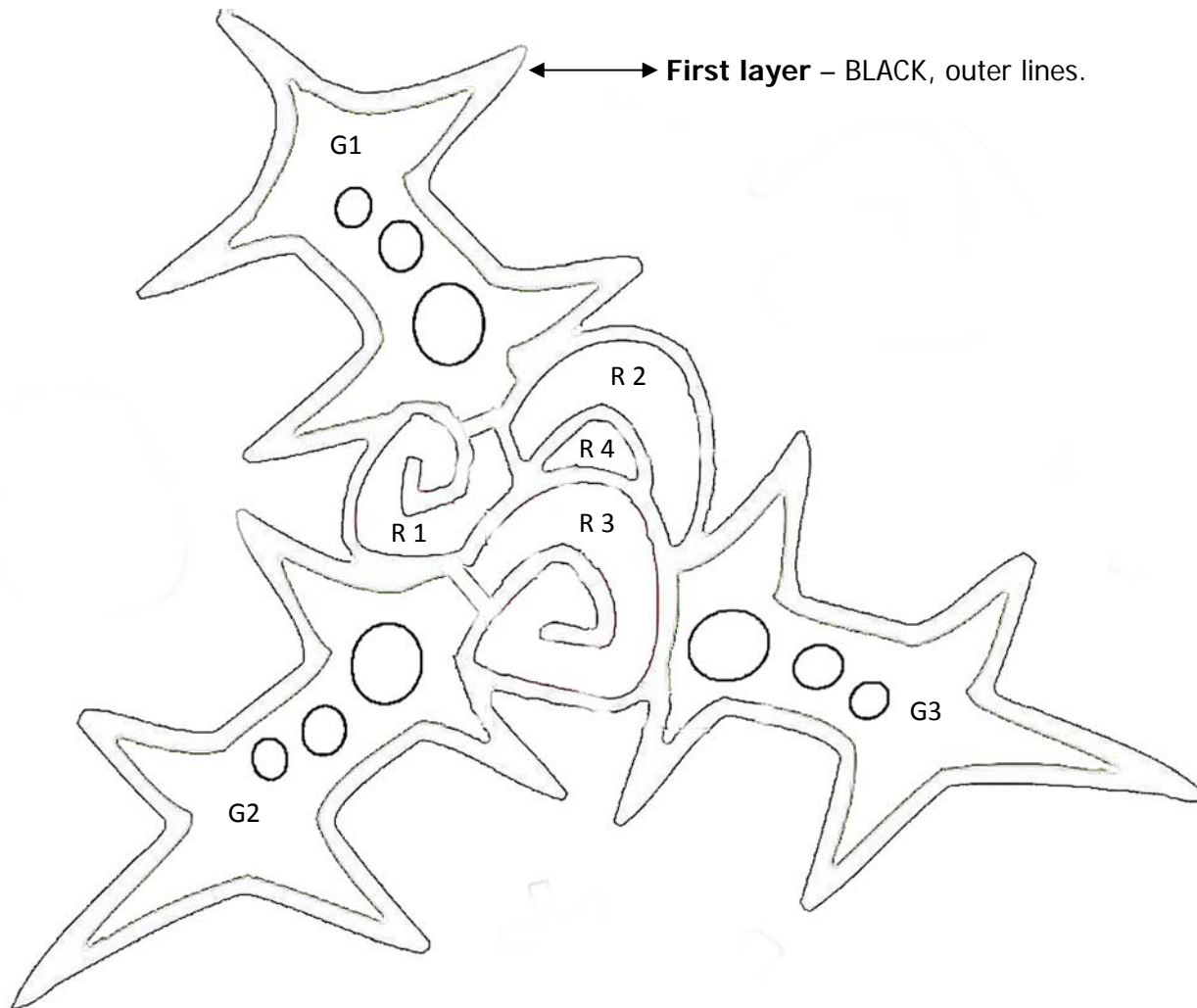


# Christmas in July BOMs



Cut one 10 inch block. This block should be a light neutral cream shade.

**R1 – R4** is RED

**G1 – G3** is GREEN

**Circles** are medium golden yellow or a paler shade of green

Trace your pattern sections to your adhesive backing.

Remember the pattern will reverse when traced. Use the diagram as a placement guide.

Cut out carefully.

The black background section is adhered to your block first. Do not glide iron over appliqué - Lift and press.

Place your green holly on next and bond.

Place the circles on and bond.

Place the red pieces on and bond.

Set on point or square.

Cut one 10 inch block. This block should be a light neutral cream shade.

**R1 – R18** is RED

**G1 – G2** is GREEN

Trace your pattern sections to your adhesive backing.

Remember the pattern will reverse when traced. Use the diagram as a placement guide.

Cut out carefully.

The black background section is adhered to your block first. Do not glide iron over appliqué - Lift and press.

Place your green wreath on next and bond.

Place the red bow and berries on and bond.

For **R11, R13** and **R14** I cheated and cut three additional small shapes out of the black rather than attempt to cut a tidy hole in the green fabric.

Stitch your black ribbon on with satin stitches.

Set on point or square.
