

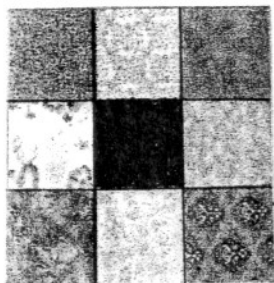
**Langley Quilters' Guild

**Disappearing 9 Patch**

**Unfinished Block Size: 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"**

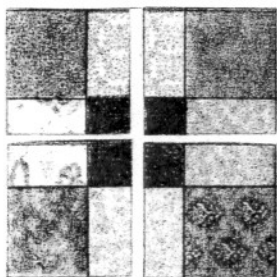
**Fabric used will be assorted "I Spy" fabrics cut into 8 (4 1/2") squares.**

**Cut a 4 1/2" square of red fabric for the center of the 9 Patch.**

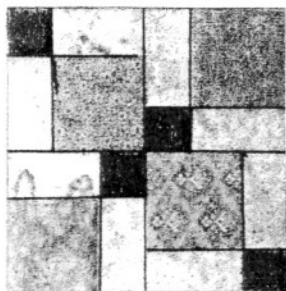


**The Disappearing 9 Patch is great. It is a very easy block to make and can look quite impressive when done.**

**First step is to make a 9 Patch. If you have light and dark "I Spy" fabrics, arrange the darkest fabrics as the X of the 9 Patch making sure the red square is in the center.**



**Cut through the completed 9 Patch both vertically and horizontally.**



**Rearrange the pattern by picking up the two blocks that are diagonally facing each other and turn them so that two small red squares are in the center diagonal to each other and two small red squares are at the opposite corners. Stitch the four blocks together to make a Disappearing 9 Patch block.**
