

**LANGLEY QUILTER'S GUILD BLOCK OF THE MONTH  
FEBRUARY 2008 (for March meeting)**

**TEA TIME - A 2-block set, each block is 7 1 / 2" finished**

With Spring just around the corner, we thought a Springtime Tea would be a good theme for this month. This is a 2 block set, an appliquéd cup block and a saucer block.

**Fabric requirements:**

Medium value small print:

(2) 8" squares, 1 for saucer, 1 for cup applique

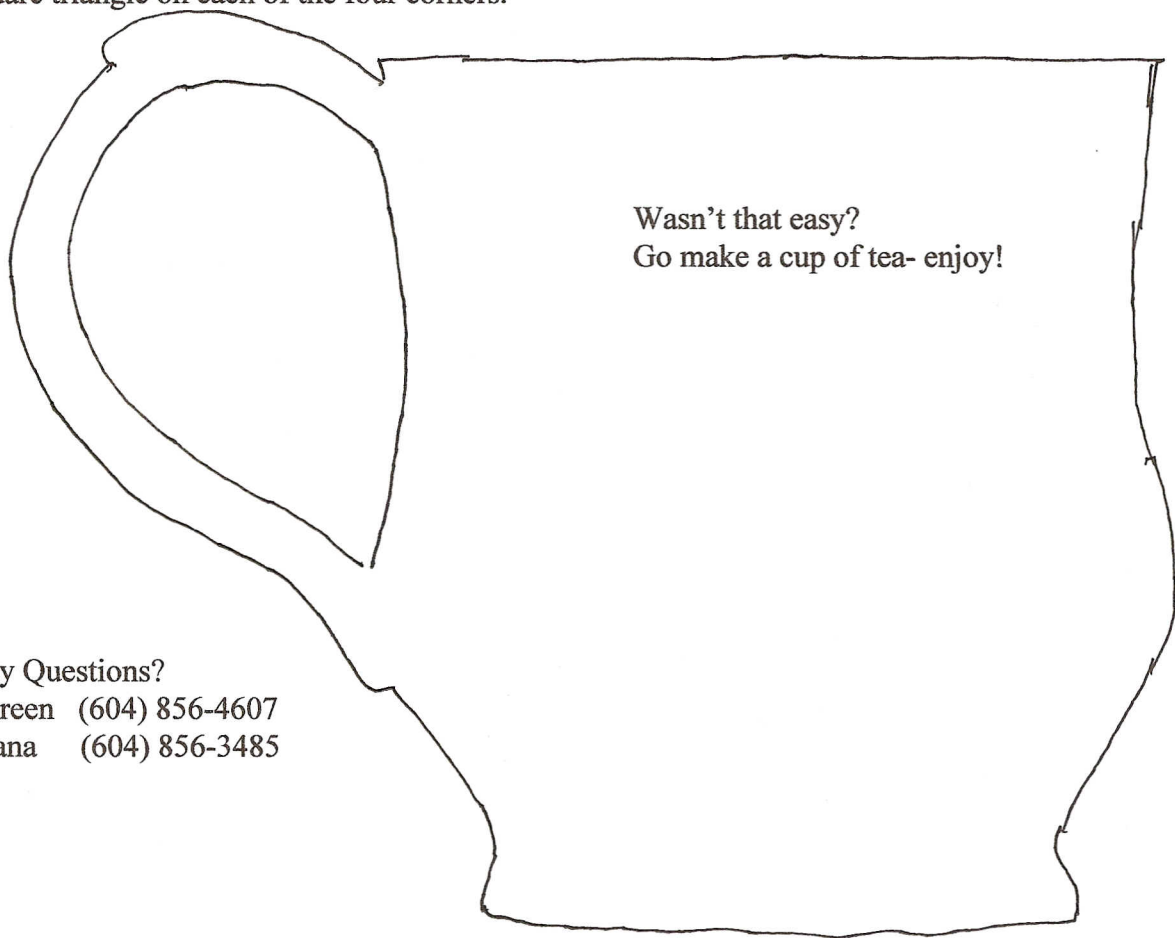
Cream background:

(1) 8" square - cup background

(4) 3" squares - "snowball" corners on saucer

**Assembly: Cup:** Using the cream 8" square as your background, center and applique a print cup using your choice of applique method (fusible with machine applique or hand applique). **Note:** If you are going to hand applique the cup, be sure to add the turn-under allowance to the pattern.

**Saucer:** (This is just a Snowball block) -Draw a diagonal stitching line on each of the 3" squares. With right sides together, stitch one 3" square on each of the four corners of the remaining 8" print block, trim seam. You should now have a half-square triangle on each of the four corners.
