Block of the Month
For the October 2008 Meeting**

“Autumn Plaid”

Block Size 12 ½” X 12 ½” unfinished

Choose two “autumn” fabrics: one a print and the second a tone-on-tone or a plain to contrast with the print fabric.

From the Print Fabric:

cut 1 strip 4 ½” x 15”

cut 1 strip 2 ½” x 15”

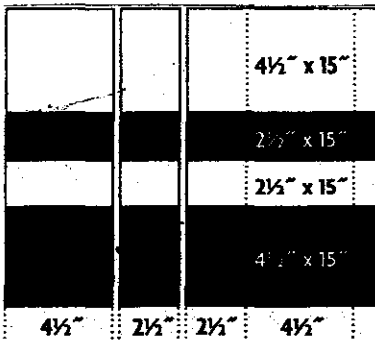
From the Tone-on-tone or Plain Fabric:

cut 1 strip 4 ½” x 15”

cut 1 strip 2 ½” x 15”

Arrange the strips as shown:

Sew the strips together and press the seams toward the darker fabric.



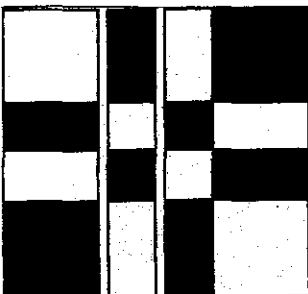
Trim the left edge to square up the band.

Cut cross strips as shown above: 4 ½”, 2 ½”, 2 ½”, 4 ½”.

There will be a small strip left over.

Arrange these strips as shown below and sew together.

Press and trim if necessary to make a 12 ½” block.
