Block of the Month  
For The May Meeting**

**Butterfly Effect**

**Block Size, unfinished:** 9 ½" x 10 ½"

For this simple "Butterfly" block, you will need a Dark body fabric, a Medium wing fabric, and a Light background fabric. The border fabric can be the same as the body fabric.

**Cutting:**

From the **Light** background fabric, cut 2 - 2" squares and 4 - 3 ¼" squares.

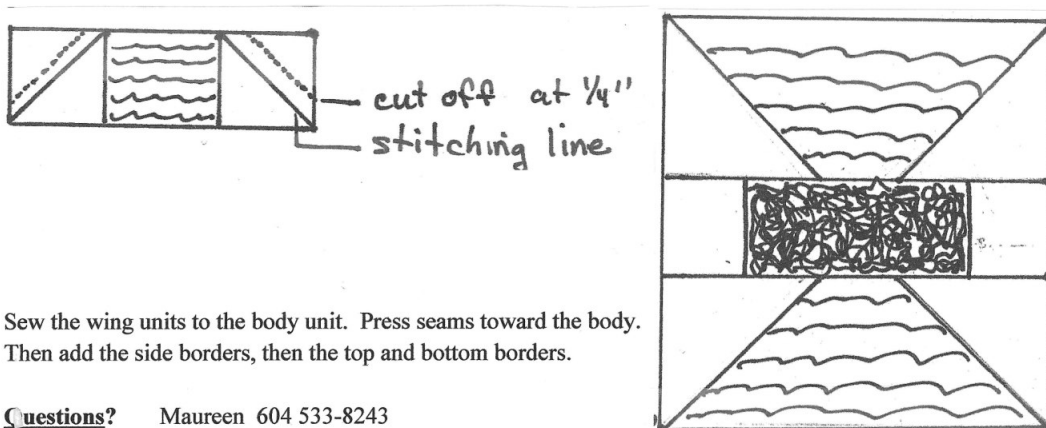
From the **Medium** wing fabric, cut 2 - 3 ¼" x 8 ½" rectangles.

From the **Dark** body fabric, cut 1 - 2" x 5 ½" rectangle.

**For the borders**, cut two 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips for the top and bottom borders and two 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips for the side borders.

Sew a 2" square at the ends of the dark 2" x 5 ½" dark body rectangle. Press seams toward the rectangle.

Place a 3 ¼" square on each end of a 3 ¼" x 8 ½" medium wing rectangle. Draw a diagonal line as shown, stitch on the line and trim seam to ¼". Press triangles open to form a new rectangle.



Sew the wing units to the body unit. Press seams toward the body. Then add the side borders, then the top and bottom borders.
