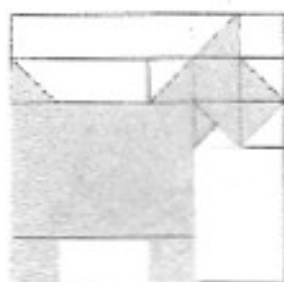
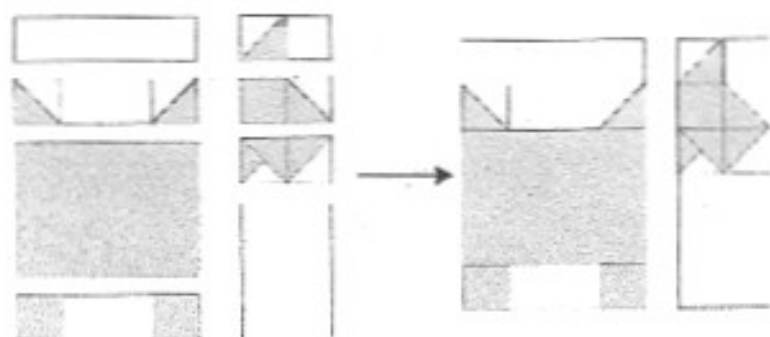


Scottie Dog Block



Black dog Body – cut:

1. One $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ bar
2. Three $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ squares
3. three $3'' \times 3''$ squares
4. one $3\frac{1}{4}''$ square

Sewing Instructions

1. Place three $3'' \times 3''$ black squares right sides together with 3 neutral $3'' \times 3''$ squares. Draw a line down the center and sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam on either side of line. Cut along line making 6 half triangle squares. Trim to $2\frac{1}{2}''$. You will have one extra square left over.
2. Place black and neutral $3\frac{1}{4}''$ squares right sides together and draw a line down centre. Sew $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam down ONE side then cut along drawn line. Cut diagonally into half triangles. Check drawing of chin to choose the correct half triangle and add the leftover black triangle sewing longest sides together. Square to $2\frac{1}{2}''$.
3. Following placement pattern, and put block together.

Neutral off white Background-cut

1. Two $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles
2. One $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ bar
3. One $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ bar
4. One $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ square.
5. Three $3'' \times 3''$ squares
6. One $3\frac{1}{4}''$ square
