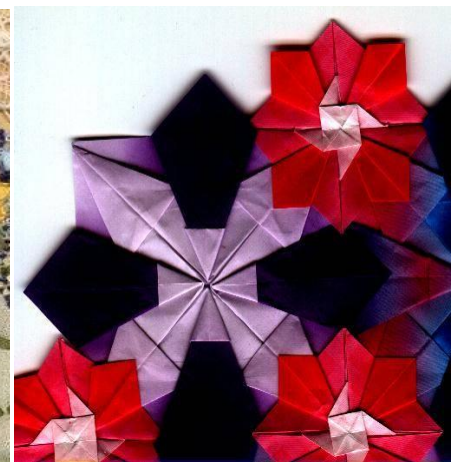
# Embellish

**Beads, Buttons, Charms, Lace, Ribbon, Doilies, Felt,**  
Hand Embroidery, Machine Embroidery, Cross Stitching,  
Decorative Sewing Machine Stitching, Silk Flowers, Braids, Couching,  
Paint, Fabric Markers, Grommets, Layering fabrics other than cotton, Texturizing,  
Hot-Fix Crystals, Sequins, Rick Rack, Iron On Patches, Medals, Shells, Calligraphy, Chain.

**e m · b e l · l i s h** – verb

1. To make beautiful, as by ornamentation; decorate.
2. To heighten the attractiveness of by adding decorative or fanciful details : ENHANCE

There are no limits to what you can use to embellish as long as it adds dimension to the fabric surface.



This month you can sew any block(s) you like, simple or complex, or use a BOM block that you have not found a use for yet. In fact, you can cut out a plain ten inch square and let your imagination do the rest and embellish your block! You are not limited to the embellishments noted above.

**There is only one rule! You must use TWO different types of embellishment.**
