

WHIRLEY STAR

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Background Fabric:- 12 rectangles.... 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric A:- 12 squares.... 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
4 rectangles.... 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Fabric B:- 8 squares.....2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
2 squares.....3" x 3"

Fabric C:- 2 squares.....3" x 3"

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1. Pair each of the Fabric B 3" square with Fabric C 3" square right sides together. On the back of top squares lightly draw a diagonal line and sew 1/4" on each side of drawn line. Cut apart on this line to get two half square units. Trim to measure 2 1/2" squares. This will make a total of four. See Diagram 1.

Step 2. Sew units from Step 1 together to form a windmill block measuring 4 1/2" square. See Diagram 2.

Step 3. Sew eight Fabric B 2 1/2" squares to four Fabric A 4 1/2 x 2 1/2 rectangles to form four flying geese units. See Diagram 3.

Step 4. Sew eight Fabric A 2 1 1/2" squares to four Background Fabric 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles to form four flying geese units. See Diagram 3.

Step 5. Mark diagonal line on four Fabric A 2 1/2" squares and sew to corners of four Background Fabric 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles to form four units. Sew 2 squares in opposite direction. See Diagram 4.

Step 6. Sew four Background Fabric 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles to Step 5 rectangles. Each unit will measure 4 1/2" square. See Diagram 5.

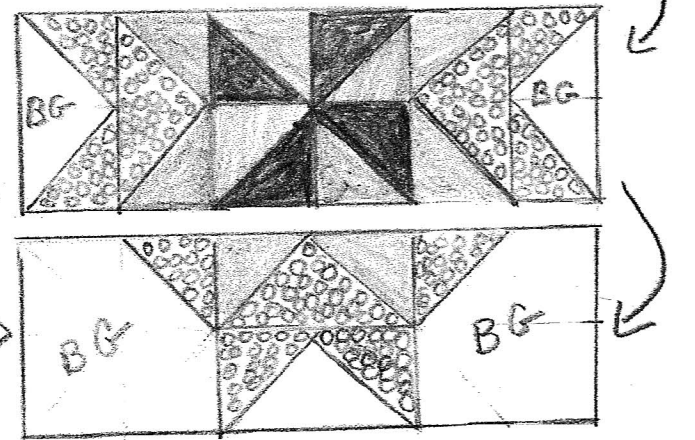
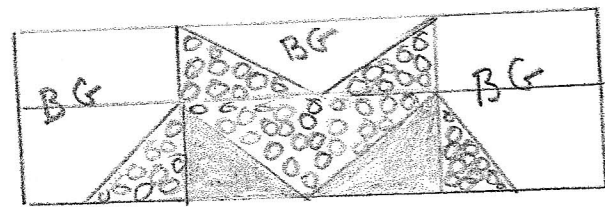
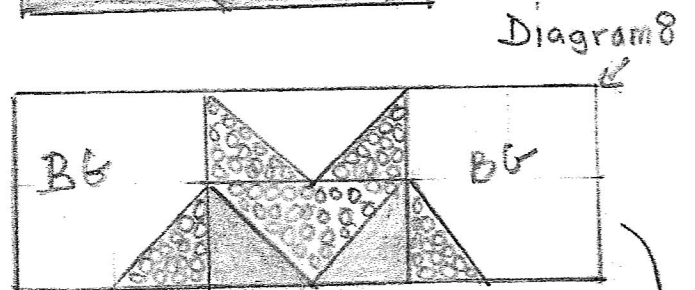
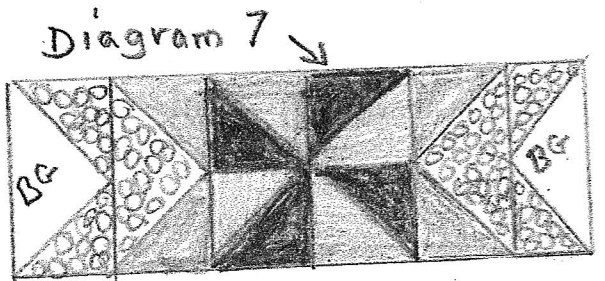
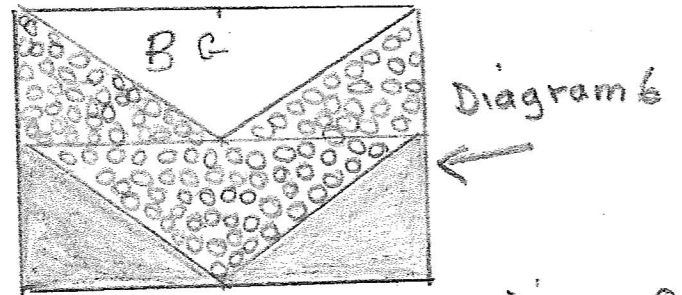
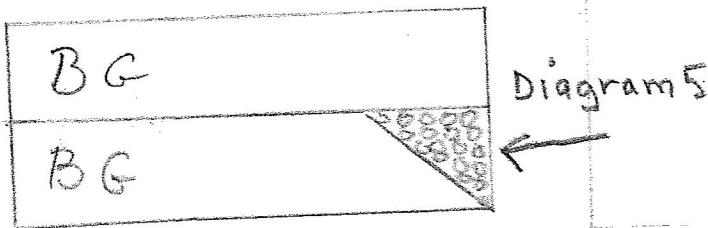
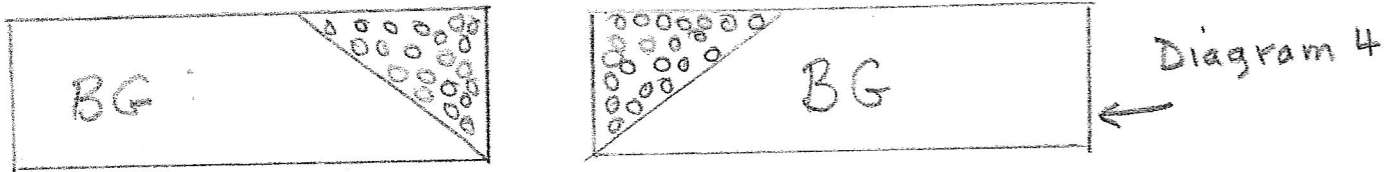
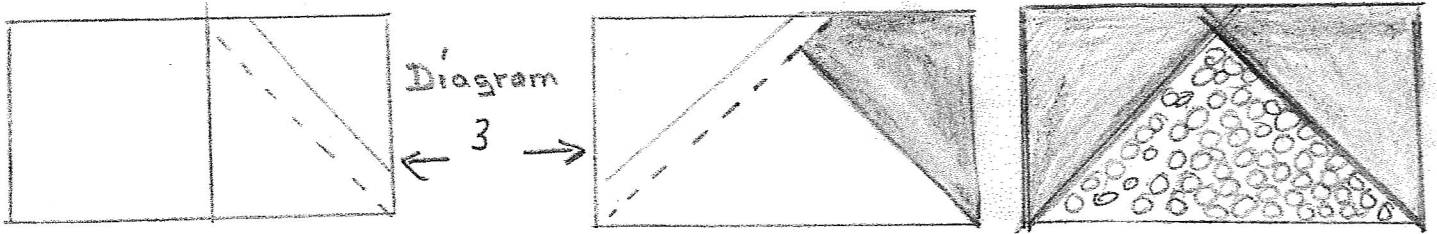
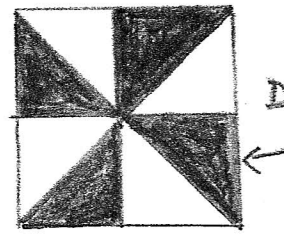
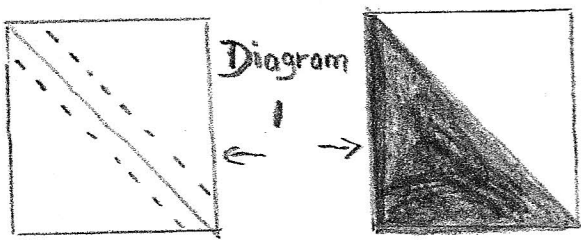
Step 7. Sew flying geese units from Step 3 to flying geese units from Step 4. These four units will measure 4 1/2" square. See Diagram 6.

Step 8. Sew two flying geese units from Step 7 to either side of Pinwheel block from Step 1. This unit will measure 4 1/2" x 12 1/2". See Diagram 7.

Step 9. Sew two units from Step 6 to either side of flying geese units. Make two units. These units will measure 4 1/2" x 12 1/2". See Diagram 8.

Step 10. Sew the two units from Step 9 to either side of unit from Step 8. The block will measure 12 1/2" square. See Diagram 9.
