

# Rolling Star

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Colour A (background): 8 - 2 1/2" squares, 2 - 3" squares,  
1 - 5 1/2" square cut on the diagonal twice

Colour B: 1 - 4 1/2" square, 1 - 5 1/2" square cut on the diagonal twice

Colour C: 2 - 3" squares; 2 - 5" squares cut on the diagonal once

Colour D: 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

(Colour B 4 1/2" square can be your choice of fabric or you could use your background fabric)

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Refer to Diagram)

1. Make half-square triangles from Background fabric A and colour C fabric 3 squares, by marking diagonal lines on four of them, placing right sides together, sewing 1/4" on either side of drawn line, cutting on the drawn line, ironing light side to dark side and trimming to 2 1/2" squares.
2. Sew 2 1/2" squares of background fabric A to one end of fabric D rectangles by sewing down your marked diagonal line, press and trim excess fabric 1/4" from sewn line, leaving fabric D intact. (see diagram for placement angle).
3. Sew half-square triangles from step 1 to 2 1/2" squares of background fabric.
4. Sew rectangles from step 2 to units made in step 3. These units will measure 4 1/2" square and form the corner units.
5. Using the colour chart as a guide, sew triangles from fabrics A and B (from the 5 1/2" squares cut on the diagonal twice)
6. Sew the triangles from step 5 to colour C triangles. Trim to 4 1/2" square.
7. Sew units made in step 4 to either side of the two units made in step 6. Refer to the diagram for correct placement. These units measure 4 1/2" x 12 1/2".
8. Sew remaining two units made in step 6 to either side of colour chosen for center square B. This unit will measure 4 1/2" x 12 1/2".
9. Sew units made in step 7 to either side of unit made in step 8. Block measures 12 1/2" square.
