

## PATIENCE CORNER Four Patch

You will need the following fabrics:

Option 1

Patch 1 & 3 – 2 Muslin or light background & 2 medium

Patch 2 – All 4 same dark fabric

Option 2

Patch 1 – 2 medium & 2 dark

Patch 2 – 4 muslin (light background)

Patch 3 – 2 medium & 2 dark

There are many other options – your imagination is the limit!

### Cutting for individual blocks:

Patch 1: 4 – 2½" X 4½" rectangles

Patch 2: 4 – 4 ½" squares

Patch 3: 4 – 2 ½" X 6 ½" rectangles

### Assembly:

1. Sew patch 1 & 2 pieces together first
2. Sew this unit to patch 3
3. Assemble 4 for each block by sewing 2 units together.
4. Sew the 2 halves together by using the butted seam technique.
5. Block should measure 12 ½" UNFINISHED.

### Cutting for strip piecing:

1. Cut total of 4 strips of patch 1 fabric – 2 ½' x width of fabric
2. Cut total of 4 strips of patch 2 fabric – 4 ½" X width of fabric
3. Sew the two strips together
4. Sub-cut into 4 ½" X 6 ½"
5. Cut total of 6 strips of patch 3 fabric: 2 ½" x width of fabric – subcut into 6 ½" rectangles.

### Assembly:

6. Assemble 4 for each block by sewing 2 units together.
7. Sew the 2 halves together by using the butted seam technique.
8. Block should measure 12 ½" UNFINISHED.

To make 9 – 12 ½" blocks you will need approximately ¾m fabric of patch 2 (total) and .6m of fabric for patch 1 & 3.
