Brown Bag Challenge

To all Participants

1. Select 4 fat or long quarters (no bigger!) from your stash and place them in the brown paper bag. They do not have to co-ordinate.
2. Print your name, mailing address and email on a piece of paper and place that inside the brown bag on top of the fat quarters.
3. Bring the bag and contents to the July evening meeting and give it to Jean J. or Bonnie R.
4. At the close of the meeting pick-up your NEW brown bag from Jean or Bonnie.
5. To help coordinate/blend fabrics you received in the brown bag, you can add 1 or 2 more fabrics from your stash to aid in your quilt design.
6. Construct a small quilt using each of the received fabrics and bring to the September meeting . The fabrics must be identifiable on the front of the quilt.

Notes:

1. You will be given the name of the participant that received your bag of fabrics. If you wish, you can send her anonymous encouragement along the way.
2. The resulting quilts can be donated to charity, saved for the quilt show, kept by the maker or bargained for by the participants.
3. Get those creative juices flowing and have fun.
4. There will voting in fun categories on the finished quilts.
5. Identities of the donors and quiltmakers remains secret until prizes are awarded.
