

SPECIAL PROJECTS (DAYTIME) - QUILT AS YOU GO COASTER

This is a fun and simple way of making coasters with a different flair. They sew up in no time flat and make wonderful little giffies or stocking stuffers for Christmas.

You will need:

Fabric A – 4 5/8" square and 3 strips of fabric 2" wide x 8" length

Fabric B – 2 strips of fabric 2" wide x 8" length

1 piece of batting 4 5/8" square

Directions:

1. Sew all 5 strips of 2" fabric together, beginning and ending with fabric A. Press all seams open.
2. Using the template provided, cut a circle from these sewn strips.
3. Clip in about 1/8" all around the edge of the circle and press under 1/4" seam all around.
4. Place your square of batting and fabric together and position exactly in the middle of the circle with the right side of fabric out.
5. Fold in four sides of the circle so that the corners are just touching.
6. Topstitch each curve down.
7. Simple and pretty – two completely different designs on the front and back.
8. You are finished – wasn't that easy?
