

## Gift Card Holder.



Instead of giving a gift card in an envelope or attached to the card when purchased just slip one into this handy holder. You can make them for any occasion, Birthdays, Xmas, Easter or just a Thank you Gift. Make one for yourself to keep your cards in. They can be made longer to suit lottery tickets.

These can be made up in seconds from your scrap pile

### You will need:

- 1 Piece of fabric 5" x 6" (outside of holder)
- 3 Pieces of fabric 5" X 5" (2 side pockets and lining)
- 1 Piece of stabilizer 5" x 6" (depending on how rigid you would like the holder to be)

### Instructions:

Fold piece of fabric in half lengthways with **WRONG** sides together. (Should be 2 1/2" x 5") Repeat to make a second one.

Place 5" x 6" piece of fabric with **Right** sides up on worktable. Place the 2 rectangles on each side of the fabric.

Pin both ends in place. (You can sew or serge these in place at this time if you would like)

Centre the remaining 5" square of fabric on top with **right sides together**. (This piece does not line up with 2 of the edges only the top and bottom)

I find it easier to mark the centre of the 5" x 6" and the last 5" sq. before starting as it makes it easier to line up.

Pin all layers in place and sew a 1/4" seam around all edges.

Trim with a serrated blade or scissors if you have not used your serger.

Place your hand under the flap and turn all pieces to the right sides. Press out corners and press all edges flat.



Now you have a nice holder for your gift cards.
